



DNA sample submission form for new male registrations

As of 1st September 2016 it has been a requirement that all new male registrations are supported by a DNA profile. (See Bye law 3.0) Please use the enclosed nasal sampling kits to take the required DNA samples and return them to the Society without delay to enable our approved laboratory to produce profiles.

Provision of kits and full DNA profile costs will be funded by the society for each male registration.

All members that require a male to be registered are encouraged to apply and submit a DNA sample in the period 1st July to 31st October to ensure no increase in their male registration fees. The male registration fee applied is based on the date the office receives the DNA sample, NOT the date of application nor issue of certificate.

I confirm that the nasal samples listed overleaf came from the animal/s who's EAR TAG I have checked. By completing this form I authorise the disclosure and use of DNA profile to the society, who will use such information for the advancement of the Texel breed. The Society confirms that the intellectual property rights in the applicant's raw data belong to the applicant. The applicant agrees that all intellectual property right in genomic information and in all other data derived from the applicants data belong to the society. The Society reserves the right in its sole discretion to publish GEBVs and other such derived data.
