INTRODUCTION TO SALE:

During the spring of 2024 Robert Calvin, joint owner of the Ballyhivistock Flock along with his wife, Christine, took unwell in the form of a severe pain in the right hand-side, tiredness and shortness of breath. After admission to the Royal Victoria Hospital for 11 days pneumonia and a large Saddle Clot on the lung was diagnosed and treatment started with the expected recovery period to be over 6 months. On discharge from hospital Christine and Robert decided to have a major cull by selling all of the commercial ewes and reduce the pedigrees, both the Texel & Rouge De L'Ouest flocks, to the very best ewes and lines and a manageable total number of 40 breeding ewes.

This reduction was completed within 1 week of discharge from the hospital, however a further week beyond this further tests revealed that Robert had a Sarcoma Cancer in an artery at the top of the lung which was a further reason for the restricted breathing. Following further investigations and a diagnosis of cancer spread throughout the lungs and it was decided to disperse all remaining ewes. The ewe lambs will be sold off as gimmers next year.

BALLYHIVISTOCK TEXELS:

Formed in 1991 between Samuel Simpson and his Stepson Robert Calvin the breeding in the flock initially concentrated solely on rams for the commercial flock owner, both ram lambs and shearlings, with the primary objective to produce rams with great carcasses and tight skins. Having entered local club sales and had success both with prizes and leading prices it was felt that after 19 years of breeding it was time to go to the NI National sale where on our first outing we topped at 5,000gns and averaged 2,900gns for our 3 entries.

Over the years we have built up a very good home trade for both rams and females to both pedigree and commercial breeders, local club sales are no longer attended although the flock does attend the NI National Sale on occasion.

In 2013 the flock took part in the January Gems and sold females up to 2,100gns at this sale. The flock has never undertaken ET work and it was felt that this sale as being detrimental to the flock itself so after 3 years withdrew from the sale.

The intention of the flock is to improve each year and in 2022 the ram lamb intended to be used for the majority of the breeding was unavailable and a back-up ram was purchased and used, unfortunately it was felt that his females would not be taking the flock forward so it was decided to sell all the ewe lambs off that ram and purchase higher quality ewe lambs from specific breeding lines, hence the reason the majority of the gimmers in the sale have been bought in.

Over the years the flock has taken part in the NI Flock Competition with consistent results placing in the ewe lamb, flock and junior stock ram sections over the years, but the highlight has to be winning the Senior Stock Ram section in with Ballyhivistock Dan Dare in 2021 as a shearling ram, he was a son of 4,000gn Curley Boudicca, his daughters have bred exceptionally as have his brothers, Ballyhivistock Danny Boy, who was also used in the flock. Daughters of both are available in the sale.

The texel flock has provided Christine and I with a considerable amount of enjoyment and pleasure over the years and we have met some wonderful people through our involvement in the breed.

This has been a very difficult decision, but the only reasonable one in the current circumstances, and we wish purchasers every success with their investment in Ballyhivistock Texel Females.

BALLYHIVISTOCK ROUGE DE L'OUEST:

Rouge rams had been used for a number of years on texel gimmers the first year and to sweep the main texel flock and in 2006 it was decided to purchase a small number of females with the intention of breeding pedigree rouge both for sale and to cross with the texel to breed commercial ewes. This was very much an aside to the Texels and although we enjoyed the Rouge our Texels were proving increasingly popular so in 2012 the decision was taken to concentrate on the Texels and the Rouge were sold.

In the interim period the few retained rouge ewes were put to the texel ram to breed Rouge x Texel Females and we also purchased a small number of rouge ewes from Moore Hamilton's Glengalliagh Flock for the for the same purpose, two of these ewes were sisters purchased as ewe lambs were MAH P58 and MAH P59, who although they were not large in stature themselves bred big lambs and did a terrific job of rearing them. In 2017 with Christine's encouragement it was decided to resurrect the pedigree flock with 6 ewes, including Kinsella Naomi who was Champion at the In-Lamb Sale 2017 and a ewe lamb, Ruval Tracy, purchased privately from Alan & Ruby Wallace. George Knox kindly offered the use of the famous Kinsella Nemo on the 5 other ewes in the flock which resulted in a great combination.

Our first outing to the Rouge Premier Sale in Dungannon in 2018 could not have gone better as it resulted in us receiving the Champion for Ballyhivistock Upperclass who sold to a trio of breeders, Upperclass was out of MAH P58, however the intended lead ram was Ballyhivistock Ultimate who sold privately prior to the sale and is considered the best rouge bred in the flock to date and was a son of MAH P59.

We continued to attend the Rouge Premier Sale since then including the following notable results:

- 2019 1st prize open ram lamb and 1st prize ewe lamb, the ewe lamb, Ballyhivistock Valkyrie, a daughter of Ruval Tracy, stood Champion
- 2021 1st Prize ewe lamb, female Champion and Reserve Overall Champion with Ballyhivistock You Beauty and the top price ewe lamb with Ballyhivistock Yvonne, 1,100gns.
- 2023 1st Prize Ram Lamb with Ballyhivistock Blue Eyed Boy.

We have always done a small amount of showing with the Rouge and Texels by supporting our local Ballymoney Show when possible. But in 2023 the Rouge Club decided to run a National Show and as Vice-Chairman I felt it was important we supported as many shows as possible, this meant a first daunting run out to Balmoral Show. It was decided early on that we had a good batch of ram lambs and ewe lambs and to mix them up throughout the shows, four or the ewe lambs were placed first at different shows, including Balmoral and the National Show all ewe lambs were retained and are in this sale a gimmers, including:

Ballyhivistock Betty who was First Prize ewe lamb at Balmoral 2023 and sells in aid of the Boom Foundation.

We shall be sad to see the rouge go, we have found them prolific, easy managed, consistent breed which is so underrated. We wish purchasers every success with their investment in Ballyhivistock Rouge Females.
